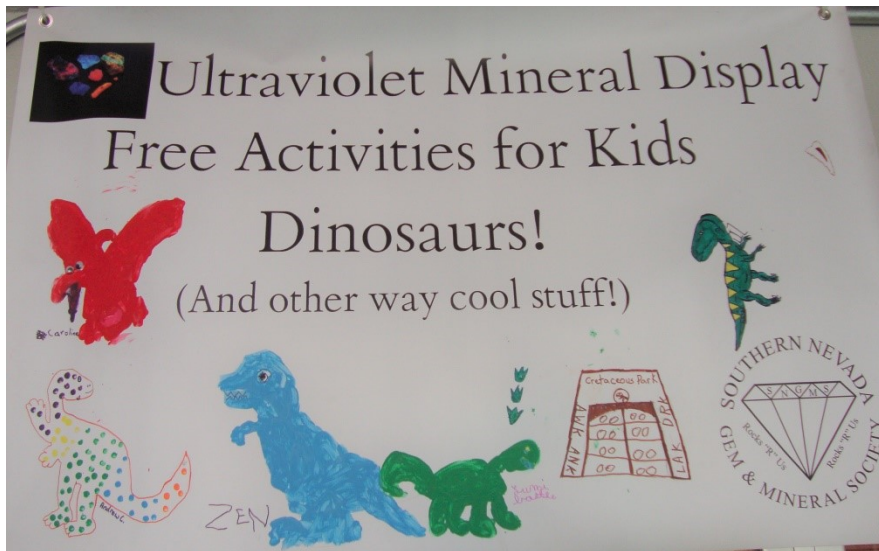


SNGMS Annual

This will be the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Show as part of the Spring Jamboree, and is always held in the Parks & Recreational Bldg located at 900 Arizona Street next to Bicentennial Park and town side of F&B aisle.

The club provides exhibits and activities geared to children including: geode sale and cutting, strolling dinosaurs, mineral and rock showcases (including fossils), free interactive stations such as "touch me" rock tables, dinosaur coloring, "live" volcano, T-rex skeleton display and new in 2020 -- dig for dinosaur eggs. Other demonstrations such as gold-panning, cabochon polishing, wire-wrapping and beading appeal to all ages.



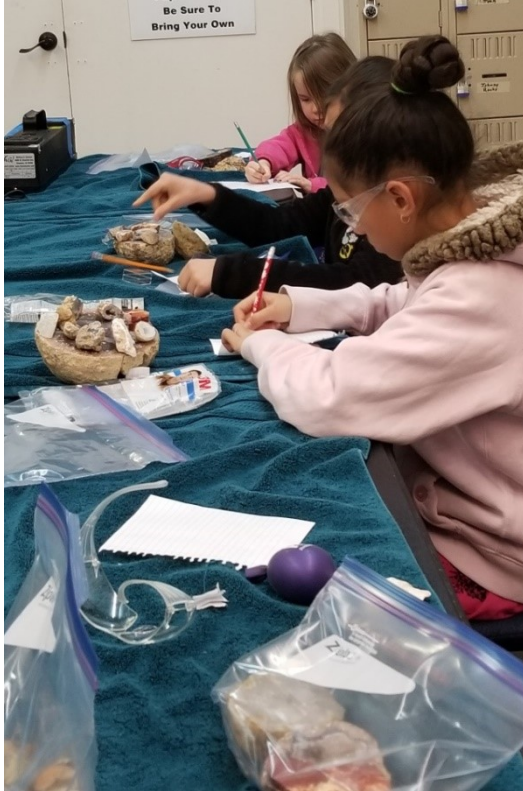
